

NLS Technology/IT Committee - 2021

Purpose

The Technology/IT Committee shall assist the Executive Committee in fulfilling the long-term goals and objectives of the NLS. The committee will report its activities to the Executive Director bi-monthly or upon request and will meet as often as needed.

Membership

The Executive Committee will appoint a minimum of two members and a maximum of four members including the Database Coordinator and Webmaster, who will exhibit trained skills to evaluate what, if and how projects and products fit into NLS's long-term strategic goals. Each committee member will serve at the will of the Executive Committee for a three-year term. The Executive Committee will fill committee vacancies and may remove a member from the committee at any time without cause.

Responsibilities

- Create a technology future state "roadmap" incorporating current, sustainable, technologies to facilitate the growth and activity of our ministry
- Become a technology resource for each Affiliated Secretariat – to educate and share best practices.
- Develop and monitor guidelines and procedures regarding data retention, recordkeeping and other compliance programs while working with the organization's internal, external legal and accounting professionals to properly define appropriate policies.
- Recommend technology and procedures with respect to data privacy, data retention and data protection to effectively manage internal data long-term strategic goals.
- Prioritize and track fulfilled ideas and report such information to the Executive Committee.
- Stay abreast of new basic technologies and emerging technologies.
- Understand e-mail, Web and other potential security threats to long-term strategic goals.
- If necessary, accelerate the need to improve and secure technology from the increased reliance on the public Internet and unsecure wireless access.
- Submit a status report at the Annual Gathering,

Meetings

The Committee Chair will keep a copy of the committee meeting minutes and forward a copy to the Executive Director and the NLS Secretary. The Committee Chair may invite any advisor who is not a member of the committee to attend, but these individuals have no voting power.
